11:00am-1:00pm	Session I "Chola Maati": Pardhan Gond Rituals from Birth to Death <i>This session explores how indigenous communities model sustainable living through resource stewardship, biodiversity conservation, and harmonious human-nature relationships. It invites reflection on ethical borrowing and community-led conservation.</i> It includes a presentation followed by a panel discussion with authors of Chola Maati: Pardhan Gond Rituals from Birth to Death, Ms. Padmaja Srivastava , architect and promoter of India's folk and tribal arts; Ms. Komal Bedi Sohal , creative designer and former Chief Creative Officer at Saatchi & Saatchi Dubai; and Mr. Mayank Singh Shyam , well known Gond artist, in conversation with Dr. Shivangi Pareek , a sociocultural and a postdoctoral research affiliate at the Yale InterAsia Initiative. Drawing from their book they will offer insights into how rituals, songs, oral traditions and lived knowledge of the Pardhan Gond community, provides a textured and holistic worldview. More than a record, it animates cultural experience through art, photography and narrative, revealing a world in which human life is deeply interwoven with earth, water, ancestors, forests and the unseen.

	<p>Session II “Beyond the Conflict”: Movie Screening & Discussion <i>This session will have a film screening of filmmaker Atharva Raut’s critically acclaimed work Beyond the Conflict followed by a discussion with Dr. Varad Giri, Head Scientist at Reliance Foundation.</i></p> <p>2:00pm - 4:00pm</p> <p>In the film, we witness how Mumbai has experienced intermittent episodes of human-leopard conflict over several decades. The Rescue team of Sanjay Gandhi National Park (SGNP) go above and beyond to mitigate this conflict where the leopards are voiceless victims. This film unravels the story of interwoven lives of the leopards and people that care for them at the SGNP Rescue Centre. This is an unseen story that showcases the themes of dedication, compassion and tragedy that exist beyond the obvious conflict.</p> <p>The discussion will help participants gain a deeper understanding of coexistence in shared landscapes, the practical and ethical dimensions of conservation, and the emotional realities that shape human-wildlife relationships.</p>

Ms Padmaja Srivastava

Architect and Promoter of India's Folk and Tribal Arts

Padmaja Srivastava is an architect, researcher, art curator, and writer who is a dedicated promoter and activist for the folk and tribal arts of central India. She is the author of the book *Chola Maati: Pardhan Gond Rituals from Birth to Death*, a comprehensive work documenting the life cycle rituals of the Pardhan Gond community. Acting as a vital link, she has been the bridge for projects between the artists and prestigious organizations like Samsung, Hyundai and Pernod Ricard. She is also an active member of a French NGO, Association Duppata, that promotes Indian tribal art in France.

Ms Komal Bedi Sohal

Creative Designer and Former Chief Creative Officer at Saatchi & Saatchi Dubai

Komal Bedi Sohal is an internationally acclaimed creative director, designer, and photographer whose practice bridges narrative, design, and documentary realism. With over three decades in advertising - winning multiple Cannes Lions and serving on the Cannes Lions Jury - she brings a refined eye for storytelling, composition, and detail to photography. Her work captures candid, emotionally resonant moments of everyday life. In 2024, she was selected for the La Vie Un Bleu International Photography Residency, Nice, and has exhibited internationally across Europe, North America, and India.



Mr Mayank Singh Shyam

Gond Artist

An acclaimed Gond artist, Mayank Singh Shyam is known for his unique depictions of modern cities, while incorporating aesthetic traditions of his community. An artist working in the tradition of Pradhan Gond painting, also known as Jangarh Kalam, Mayank Singh Shyam is also the son of the celebrated Pradhan artist, Jangarh Singh Shyam. His works were also included in the Indian Contemporary Art auction at Sotheby's, New York, Organized for the benefit of Kolkata Museum of Modern Art. In 2006 Mayank was Conferred the state award by the Hasta Shilpa Evam Hathkargha Vikas Nigam, Bhopal.

Dr Shivangi Pareek

Sociocultural Anthropologist

Dr. Shivangi Pareek is a sociocultural anthropologist interested in questions of decolonization and development in South Asia. She is currently a postdoctoral research affiliate at the Yale InterAsia Initiative. She holds a B.A. and an M.A. in literature from Delhi University and a Ph.D. in socio-cultural anthropology from Yale University. For her Ph.D. dissertation she has studied the political economy of contemporary 'tribal'/Adivasi material culture. Her current book project examines how historically marginalized and stigmatized communities like Adivasis access socio-cultural inclusion in local and global networks through their expressive culture.



Mr Atharva Raut

Wildlife Filmmaker and Photographer

Atharva Raut is a wildlife filmmaker and photographer based in Bristol, UK and Mumbai, India, with a passion for telling wildlife stories that blend art, science, and conservation. Completed his Master's in Wildlife Filmmaking from UWE Bristol, UK in partnership with BBC NHU. He has contributed to conservation efforts, working on projects like mitigating human-leopard conflict around Mumbai's Sanjay Gandhi National Park and contributing to citizen science initiatives.

Dr Varad Giri

Head Scientist at Reliance Foundation

Dr. Varad Giri is a herpetologist, conservationist, and researcher trying to understand the intricacies in biodiversity. With over two decades of research, he advances biodiversity science, conservation strategies, and science communication, focusing on India's lesser-known species. Earlier worked for over a decade with the iconic Bombay Natural History Society (BNHS).

Scientific Officer at SOCLEEN

Dr Ninad Marathe is an environmental researcher focused on sustainable, community-oriented solutions. He holds a patent for a 'Biological Fluid Screening Analyzer' and authored *Fauna*.
